

RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 753

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSALS OF AJAX PAVING INDUSTRIES OF FLORIDA LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,489,179.20 AND C. W. ROBERTS CONTRACTING, INCORPORATED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,696,163.75 PERTAINING TO CONTRACT 22-C-00022; CITYWIDE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND STREET RESURFACING; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACTS BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2022, the Mayor received bids, tabulation of such bids being hereto attached for informational purposes, for the construction of Citywide Roadway Improvements and Street Resurfacing, and recommends to this Council that the proposals of Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC and C. W. Roberts Contracting, Incorporated be accepted, funds therefore being available in the appropriate account.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposals of Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC in the total amount of \$8,489,179.20 and C. W. Roberts Contracting, Incorporated in the total amount of \$8,696,163.75 for construction of the Citywide Roadway Improvements and Street Resurfacing, in accordance with plans, specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Contract Administration Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contracts are hereby awarded to the said Contractors. For convenience, the contract with Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC shall be designated 22-C-22001 and the contract with C. W. Roberts Contracting, Incorporated shall be designated 22-C-22002.

Section 2. This Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contracts for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. Plans, specifications and contract documents for the construction of said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the Contract Administration Department of the City of Tampa, are hereby approved in their entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 4. The Director of the Contract Administration Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies, said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.

Section 5. Any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the proposal of the Contractors are hereby waived.

Section 6. The bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this project.


Section 7. Award of a contract for Citywide Roadway Improvements and Street Resurfacing in the amount of \$8,489,180 for Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC and \$8,696,164 for C. W. Roberts Contracting, Inc. for a total of \$17,185,344, controlled by requisition from various funding sources for use by the Mobility Department.

Section 8. That the City Clerk shall file a fully executed copy of the Agreements in the official records of the City of Tampa as maintained by the Office of the City Clerk.

Section 9. Other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

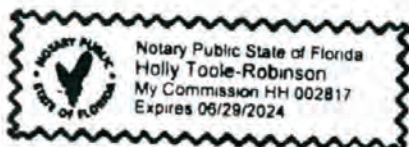

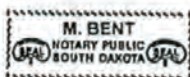



1. **Contract Title:** Citywide Roadway Improvements and Street Resurfacing
2. **Contractor:** Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC and C. W. Roberts Contracting, Inc.
3. **Purpose:** Contracts to perform construction of various roadway and safety improvements including resurfacing, drainage, and intersection improvements. Currently, the City has several projects in queue that may be utilizing these contracts, including:
 - Dist. 4
 - i. Manhattan Ave. (Richardson Ave. to Interbay Blvd.)
 - ii. Neighborhood Improvements - Belmar Shores
 - Dist. 5
 - i. Downtown Core Complete Streets (Florida Ave., Tampa St., Brorein St., Whiting St.)
 - ii. 24th St. Corridor Improvements (Chelsea St. to Emma St.)
 - Dist. 6
 - i. Rocky Point Dr. Complete Streets (South of Courtney Campbell Causeway)
 - ii. Glenn Ave. Safety Improvements

- iii. Neighborhood Improvements - West Riverside Heights
- iv. Hanna Ave.
- Dist. 7
 - i. Tampa Palms Blvd. Complete Streets

In addition to the projects already slated for construction, the task-based nature of this contract allows for the City to implement projects quickly, permitting the City to proactively prepare for federal grants or any additional local funding.

A Bid Notice was issued for this contract in July 2022. Three responses were received. The two lowest bids are reflected above. This award shall be for a one-year period with a one-year renewal. The total amount of the Resolution is \$17,185,342.95 for the first year period in the amount of \$8,489,179.20 to Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC and in the amount of \$8,696,163.75 to C. W. Roberts Contracting, Incorporated.

4. **Equal Business Opportunity Statement:** Ajax Paving Industries of Florida LLC – EBO participation totals 20.4% of which WBE=11.73%, HBE=5.75%, BBE=1.94% and 1.0% SLBE (nonminority). C.W.
